


The International Arts Examination Board's exams deliver Ofqual regulated certificates when passed and deliver internationally recognised UK & EU credits.





Remark:

- 1. Candidates who apply for the basic level/level one/level two of comprehensive painting can accept the instructor to be beside the candidate and guide the candidate orally through the entire examination assessment process so as to complete the painting on time;
- 2. However, instructors are not allowed to assist candidates in completing the entire exam assessment painting:
- 3.Instructors are not allowed to be at the exam site, videotaping or recording:
- 4. The instructor does not need to wear a mask at the examination site and needs to be able to see his face;
- 5. The instructor must be over 18 years old or above, and can be a teacher/parent/guardian. etc.:
- 6. The coverage of handicraft materials can only be accepted within 50% of the entire drawing paper;
- 7. The Comprehensive Drawing Examination is an assessment that encourages children to take part starting from the age of two, with the aim of cultivating their creativity and thinking abilities from an early age.

- 1. Candidates are free to choose any one of the six subjects and any grade from Level 1 to Level 9 as examination assessment.
- 2. For example: After candidates complete the Watercolor Painting Level 3 examination assessment and successfully obtain the certificate, they can take the Watercolor Painting Level 2 or Level 2 exam next time. Level six, and so on.
- 3. Each time you complete the examination assessment of a subject, you will receive a certificate.



Circumstance2: Get a Diploma Certificate



1. Candidates must complete the Elementary of one of the six Subjects, complete the first, second and Level 3 (Total Level 3) exams in different periods of time, and successfully obtain the certificate, as well as successfully obtain the same Subjects. Only those who have obtained Level 1 certificate of Intermediate Level 4, Level 5 or Level 6; and successfully obtained Level 1 certificate of Higher Level 7, Level 8 or Level 9 of the same Subjects can obtain an additional diploma certificate.

2. For example:


Candidates complete the Watercolor Painting Elementary Level 1, 2 and Level 3 exams and obtain certificates.

Pass the Intermediate 1st to Level 3 exam in watercolor painting and the Level 2 exam in watercolor painting

Once you take the Level 2 exam in Level 3 and obtain the certificate, you can get an additional watercolor painting diploma

Level 2 certificate.

(You must take the same exam subjects. Intermediate and Higher must apply for the same Grade to obtain a diploma.)



How long does it take to get the exam results?





Within 14 working days

Candidate results will be announced via email within 14 working days.

How can I get the certificate?



The electronic certificate will be issued by email within 14 working days.

However, the physical version of the diploma or certificate needs to be sent to the candidate's address via SF Express within two weeks, and the postage must be paid by the candidate.

To purchase a physical diploma or certificate, the cost is USD \$12.
